TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

- LOCATION:** Upton, London Road (A417)
- REASON:** To facilitate resurfacing of carriageway and subsequent reinstatement of all road markings and lines
- DURATION:** Starting on 02 December 2022
The anticipated completion date is 04 December 2022 (date included). This will operate between 19:00 and 06:00
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: via A417 (London Road), Blewbury Hill, A417, Shortlands Hill, Wantage Road, A329 (Wallingford Road), The Street, Reading Road, A4130 (Bosley Way), Calvin Thomas Way, High Road, A4130, Hadden Hill, Broadway, Wantage Road, B4493, Didcot Road, Harwell Link Road, London Road and vice versa
